Backstage Moms



Thank you for agreeing to be a backstage mom! We really appreciate your assistance at the recital. Your participation and cooperation will help to ensure the recital is a success!

Here are the rules: (and yes, *THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS!*)



- No dads backstage at any time.
- There is absolutely *NO TAPPING BACKSTAGE*. This rule must be adhered to not only for the acoustics of the show, but because of the Pavilion rules. Joanne is responsible for any and all damage to the Pavilion floor.
- Rehearsing backstage is not allowed during the recital. This is very distracting to the audience.

The dance recital process:



- At the beginning of the recital all dancers, *except those in the opening*, are to be upstairs in the dance room or in the reserved bleacher area.
- *Before* bringing your dance group down and backstage, please check to make sure all hair foofs, shoe fluffs and other costume accessories are securely attached and the dancers are ready to go.
- Keep your dance group upstairs in the dance room or bleachers until 5 dances before they are scheduled to perform.
- When you come down the back steps, please stay behind the taped line. Someone will come and bring your group to the curtain. This will be 2 dances prior to your group's dance. This is mandatory to prevent too much noise and confusion backstage.
- At this time you are free to quickly return to your seat in the audience. Sit back, relax, and enjoy your dance group's performance.
- Upon completion of the dance immediately return to the backstage area to collect your dancers. Return them back upstairs to the dance room or bleachers. Dancers may either prepare for their next dance, or be released when their parent come for them.
